Hawaii Social Host Law

Adults who provide **ALCOHOL** to those under 21 could face 1 year in jail &/or fines up to **\$2,000**.



"I was just holding it for my friend."

"It was only 1 drink."

Hawaii Use & Lose Law

You can lose your driver's license if you're under 21 & are caught drinking, buying, or holding **ALCOHOL**. And, if you're 18 or older, you could face 30 days in jail &/or fines up to **\$1,000**.
